Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult charge £2 per child

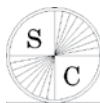

About the 15th Castles Mountain Bike Ride

The ride will leave from Croft Sports Centre at 10am and head towards a picturesque route on and off road to the Ridgeway, which is situated about four miles to the south. The ride follows the Ridgeway along ancient byways, tracks and bridle ways in a scenic loop of the Downs but always within a ten mile radius of the start/finish of the 28 mile course. Shorter course options of 10 and 19 miles are available (distances are approximate). Light refreshments will be provided.

The routes will be clearly marked and we have marshals positioned at strategic points. You should bring at least a puncture repair kit and pump, and make sure your bike is well prepared.

Please wear suitable clothing and we strongly advise that you wear a helmet. Pay attention to the Highway Code and the Country Code.

IMPORTANT - please dismount for your own safety if you find any part of the track difficult to ride over.

The **Macmillan Trophy donated by Mitchell Cycles** will be presented to the **largest finishing group of four or more riders** who complete the 19 or 28 mile course (to qualify groups must register as a team before the 3rd June 2011).

A bicycle, donated by Mitchell Cycles, will be presented to the person who raises, and hands in, the greatest amount of sponsorship money by 20th August 2011. There will be no prize for the first rider home.
